Important News Regarding a Return to Online Worship and Suspension of In-Person Worship

As many of you know, the number of COVID-19 cases in Adams County continues to increase. While we have had no reported cases with our church, we received notice from the Adams County Health Department on August 3, 2020, asking churches throughout Adams County to strongly consider suspending in-person worship services, effective immediately. Our goal has always been to "do no harm." So, with the recommendation of our Emergency Preparedness Team, and the agreement of our Administrative Council chair and Lay Leader, we are offering online worship only, effective immediately, until further notice. We also ask that access to the church for other purposes be limited.

Given this recommendation, please expect the following to take place:

Online Worship. A return to online worship occurred on Sunday, August 9. Pre-recorded videos are posted to
<u>YouTube</u>, our <u>online worship page</u> at our website, and announced through our <u>Facebook</u> page. An interactive,
Zoom Worship gathering will occur at 9:00 am each Sunday at our regular service time. Printed copies of sermon
manuscripts (for weeks when Pastor Nancy brings the message) will still be available for pick up or mailing. Please
make sure to register your attendance at our online worship page.

We have mentioned several times that it is not the church that is being closed, just the building. We continue to proclaim the Word and do ministry in Jesus' name.
